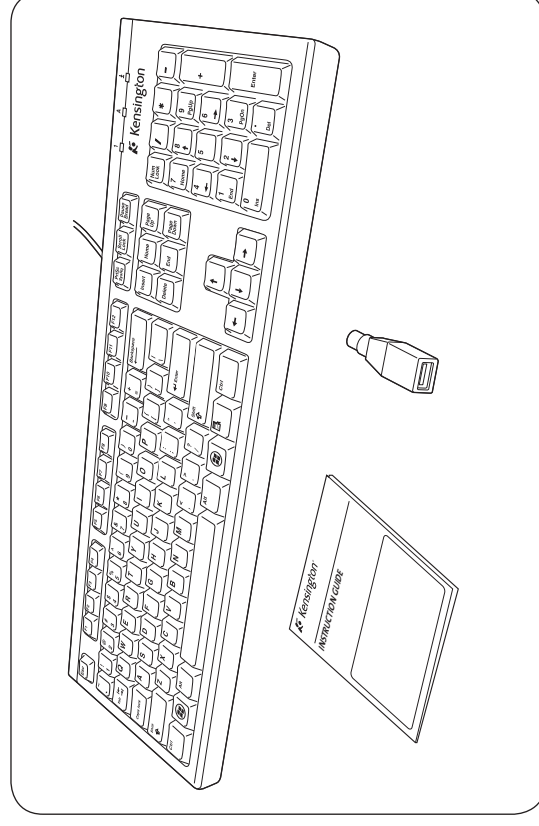

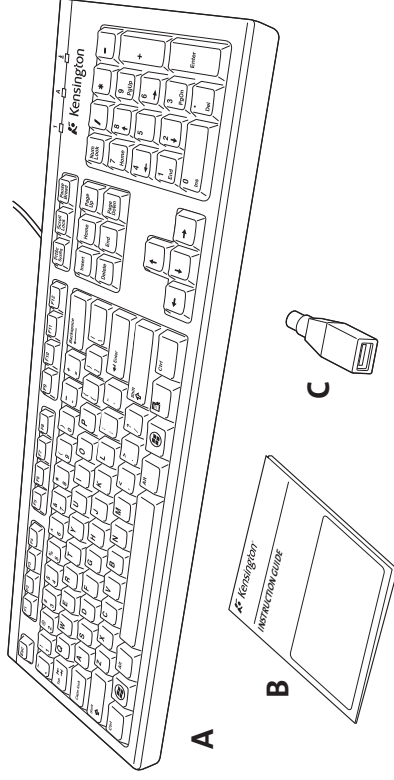

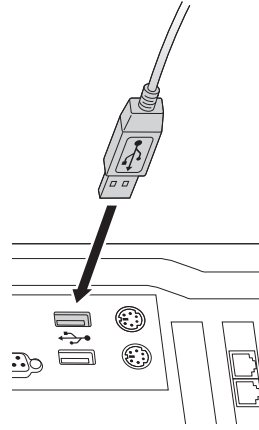

Getting Started

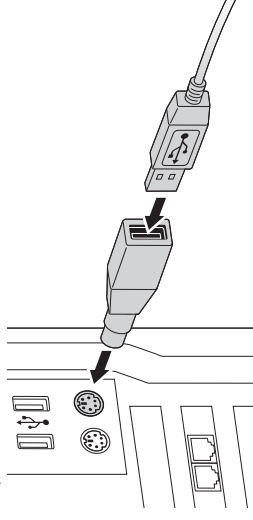
If your computer has a USB port, plug the keyboard directly into the USB port.



Or



If your computer does not have a USB port, turn off the computer. Then, install the USB/PS2 adapter into the keyboard PS2 port on your computer (often purple). Plug the keyboard cable into the USB port on the adapter. Turn computer on.
